Humanitarian projects

Infrastructure projects

Either type of Project is appropriate. Consider your gifts and passions when deciding which type of Project to pursue. Some examples of each include:

Humanitarian Project Examples

- Recondition bikes for needy kids.
- Create a toy area or book library for a school or church.
- Create educational cards or games for a community center or clinic.
- Create resident biographies and pictures for a nursing home.
- Plan, organize, and run a Vacation Bible School program for at-risk youth.
- Catalog and describe videos to create a guide for a children's ward or hospital.
- Develop and implement a program that will impact a selected group of people.
- Create and run a program to interview and record biographies from local Veterans or senior citizens of local historical interest.
- Plan and run a collection and inventory organization for a local organization.
- Inventory and re-organize supplies and materials for a local organization and construct shelves or cabinets for storage.

Infrastructure Project Examples

- Landscape for beautification or erosion control including:
 - Removal and renovation
 - Garden and raised beds
 - Drainage and retaining walls
 - Concrete, pavers, or stone work
 - Wood or stone steps
 - Compost bins
- Assembling or refurbishing playground equipment.
- Construct a new or upgraded playground.

- Construct an amphitheater at local camp or park.
- Upgrade park facilities including:
 - Fencing
 - Shelters, picnic tables
- Develop a wildlife observation or nature science area and program.
- Create permanent nature information displays.
- Create or improve a hiking or nature trail including:
 - Signage and marking for trails, plants, etc
 - Bird or bat houses
 - Pond and wildlife observation area
 - Bridges and handrails
- Construct storage and organizing supplies for an organization:
 - Shelves and space organizers
 - Benches, work tables
 - Drywall and painting
- Create a wheelchair or visually impaired accessible garden in a park.
- Create safety awareness displays for schools.
- Create public information kiosks.
- Restore a historical building.
- Restore a war memorial or historic site.
- Create outdoor activity centers for a senior center.
- Repurpose an unused space and develop a program for the space.
