## THE ROLE OF THE TROOP ONBOARDING FACILITATOR

*The Onboarding Facilitator needs to be knowledgeable of Troop operations, a connector of others, and a positive promoter of Trail Life USA.*

This role will fulfill the necessity of engaging each new member and each new family to make them feel welcomed and needed and will assure that interested families are given pertinent information to thrive within the Troop. The onboarding process will provide the answers to the *Who, What, Where, When, How, Why* and *How Much*; questions they all have!

The Onboarding Facilitator promotes discussions and must be an experienced Trail Life USA Troop leader who understands the “big picture” of the Troop’s operations.

This person should have the ability to encourage others, the skill to communicate details from the Troop Fast Start Training checklist, the capability to perceptively confirm that new families fully understand how the Troop works, and the talent to effectively relate and befriend new Troop members.

The end goal of this position is active participation of each new family in a thriving Troop program.
